A Message from the President of The Salt and Light Council

Jesus called His followers to be “the salt of the earth” and “the light of the world” (Matthew 5:13–16). Salt preserves what is good from decay; light reveals what is hidden and points the way forward. To be salt and light is not optional—it is a call to action, a mandate to engage in every sphere of life, including government and education.

Yet in our culture today, tolerance seems to extend to nearly every belief and behavior—except those grounded in the Bible. Since the 1960s, when the Supreme Court struck down prayer in schools without citing a single legal precedent, an imaginary “wall of separation” has been constructed between church and state. Over time, this wall has pushed Christian influence to the margins of politics, education, and public life.

The results are sobering: rejection of our nation's Christian heritage, open scorn for biblical truth, denial of First Amendment freedoms, and increasing hostility—even persecution—toward Christians. We are in the midst of a spiritual battle, and sitting on the sidelines is not an option. Jesus warned, “He who is not with Me is against Me” (Matthew 12:30).

That is why The Salt and Light Council exists. Our mission is to equip God's people to re-engage culture with His truth. The purpose of a Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministry is simple yet powerful: to bring Christian principles back into the public domains of government and education. This manual will show you the nature, necessity, and methods of such a ministry.

We understand that once you recognize the importance of starting a Salt & Light ministry in your church, you'll need practical support to begin and sustain it. That's where we come in. As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, The Salt & Light Council provides resources, training, and guidance to help your congregation rise to the challenge of being salt and light in our time.

We encourage you to dedicate one Sunday as Salt & Light Sunday. Preach a sermon that calls your people to step into their biblical mandate and provide a clear opportunity for engagement. With a simple table in the back of the sanctuary, staffed with sign-up sheets, you will see 10–25% of your congregation ready, willing, and able to commit to this mission.

The time is urgent. Our nation can be restored to its biblical and moral foundations—but only if God’s people take their rightful place as salt and light. This booklet is your guide. May it help you stir courage in your church, and may it spark a movement that transforms both hearts and our nation.

**Reclaim Our Judeo-Christian Heritage
by Establishing Your Own
Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministry**

**Let's Rediscover the Joy and Privilege of being a
Citizen of the United States.**

God created three societal institutions: Family, Church, and Government and together they form a three legged stool.

The blessings of God are best secured when all three legs function cooperatively and when each is firmly established in biblical truth. Fortunately, our nation's Constitution is grounded in biblical truth. However, in the words of Samuel Adams, "Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other." As "we the people" have become increasingly secularized, the very powerful leg of government has grown significantly while the legs of church and family have diminished. As a result, the stool is wobbling severely and in danger of falling over!

The Church must not retreat and let current trends continue. Indeed, God has commissioned all believers into His army, and this is a spiritual battle we have been called to engage in!

The Salt and Light Council was established to help bring the three legs back into balance, putting particular emphasis on what it means to be a Christian and a citizen of this country. Employing both spiritual weapons and practical tools, we have created a successful model for establishing independent Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries on church campuses across the country.

The collective purpose of these individual Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries is to infuse government and education with Christian principles and values. God has given to the Church the responsibility of being a nation's moral voice. Biblical Citizenship Ministries provide an effective means of making that voice heard.

Like a back-end office support team, The Salt and Light Council will help you begin and sustain a Biblical Citizenship Ministry at your church by providing training, support, guidance and resources.

Why are Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries needed?

Quite simply, the future of our nation is at stake. For the first time, Americans are doubting that the next generation will have it better than the previous one. Our free and prosperous nation seems to be unraveling. Why? We have not followed God's precepts!

2 Chronicles 7:14: If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Assaults on religious freedom have become almost commonplace... and gotten much worse in the aftermath of Obergefell v. Hodges, the Supreme Court decision in June 2015 that invented a "right" to same sex marriage. "[W]e should expect [Obergefell] to inaugurate the greatest crisis of religious liberty in American history," said Gerard Bradley, Professor of Law at the University of Notre Dame. The ramifications are for all citizens, not only Christians who affirm the right to hear and speak God's truth. As religious freedoms are taken away, all other freedoms also become vulnerable to attack, including freedom of speech, personal property rights, economic freedom, etc.

Tragically, the Church is no longer widely perceived to be the bearer of God's love, transcendent truth, and goodness. Although this may seem a rather recent phenomenon, a closer look reveals that a long, methodical march by the enemy has brought us to this point in history. And it will take a determined and prayerful response by God's people to restore our nation to its biblical foundations and position us to again receive God's blessings and not His judgments.

Are there particular issues on which Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries focus?

There are six prominent issues that we consider to be "the non-negotiables." What some call political issues are, in fact, deeply moral ones. Our role at the ballot box is to consider them carefully through the lens of scripture and our Judeo-Christian inheritance.

Religious Freedom We support freedom of religion as guaranteed in our Constitution. We oppose any infringement of this right and any artificially imposed obstacles to our responsibility to unapologetically preach the whole gospel. The principal reason America was founded as a new nation was for people to be able to worship the God of the Bible freely, without government interference. The first guarantee of the Bill of Rights in our U.S. Constitution is that no law will be made “respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof.” We must learn to vote for the Candidate who will best support and defend our unalienable religious liberties. (Acts 5:29; Romans 13:1)

Acts 5:29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: “We ought to obey God rather than men.”

Romans 13:1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and he authorities that exist are appointed by God.

The Sanctity of Human Life We support adoption, community-based pregnancy care centers and adult stem cell research. We oppose abortion, euthanasia, and embryonic stem cell research. Biblical Voters cannot contentiously vote for a candidate who supports Abortion, Euthanasia, or Embryonic Stem-Cell Research. Scripture teaches all human life is sacred. Abortion is the killing of a human life in what should be its safest sanctuary, the womb of his or her mother. In fact, did you know that no creature in the animal kingdom kills its own unborn in the womb—only sinful humans do this. Euthanasia assists in ending a life. Embryonic Stem-Cell Research utilizes aborted baby parts. (Leviticus 17:11a; Job 31:15; Jeremiah 1:5; Psalm 139:13-16; Proverbs 6:16-17).

Leviticus 17:11a For the life of the flesh is in the blood...

Job 31:15 Did not He who made me in the womb make them? Did not the same One fashion us in the womb?

Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations.

Psalm 139:13–16 For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, and skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when as yet there were none of them.

Proverbs 6:16–17 These six things the Lord hates, yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood,

Marriage

The Bible emphatically declares that marriage is only to be between one man and one woman. Jesus Christ affirmed this and said this has always been God's plan from the beginning. Biblical Voters must vote only for candidates who affirm their belief in, and support for, the Biblical definition of natural marriage, and who will oppose "same-sex" marriage. (Matthew 19:4-6) Marriage was created by God and it is not man's prerogative to redefine it. We support natural marriage and oppose the enforcement of all alternative definitions.

Sexuality

God made us male or female. Your sex is determined by almighty God long before conception and revealed to all at birth. Thinking oneself to be a different sex doesn't make it so. Your sex is determined by almighty God and revealed to all at birth. Thinking yourself to be an arbitrary "gender," or sexual category, doesn't make it so. Sex is determined by God's design, not what is between your ears. Scripture says those who don't retain God in their knowledge become fools, though they think themselves wise. Any sexual activity outside the bounds of marriage between one man and one woman is unacceptable to God. Biblical Voters must vote for candidates who support maintaining the biological distinction between male and female and keeping sex within natural marriage. (Genesis 1:27; Leviticus 18:22; Romans 1:27-27; Psalm 139:13-16).

Genesis 1:27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Leviticus 18:22 You shall not lie with a male as with a woman. It is an abomination

Romans 1:26–27 For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

Psalms 139:13–16 For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, and skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when as yet there were none of them.

The Family

From marriage comes the family unit, which is the basic building block of society and demonstrably the best environment for raising the next generation. We support efforts to strengthen the family and oppose undermining parental authority or the integrity of the family.

Support for the Jewish People (Israel)

God promises blessings to those who look out for His chosen people, the Jews. We support Israel and oppose radical Islam. Similarly, we oppose the establishment of Sharia law in our country, which is a means of enslaving people, not liberating them. Whoever blesses Israel will be blessed; whoever curses Israel will be cursed. There are national as well as individual consequences that are ensconced in Scripture. Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord. Biblical Voters will vote for the Candidates who will best support Israel (Genesis 12:3; Psalm 122:6; Psalm 33:12).

Genesis 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

Psalm 122:6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you."

Psalm 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance.

Is there a biblical mandate for the Church to be engaged in the public sector? YES! Government is ordained by God.

The purpose of government is to encourage good and to restrain evil in society. (Romans 13:1; Romans 13:4; Colossians 1:16; Daniel 2:21)

Romans 13:1 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

Romans 13:4 For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil.

Colossians 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him.

Daniel 2:21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding.

Good Government (A Consequence Of Having Good Leadership) Benefits All Of Society. Scripture Instructs Us To Select Godly Leaders To Be Our Governing Authorities. (Exodus 18:21; Proverbs 29:2) In the Republic of the United States, we the people delegate to our elected representatives the authority to govern, in a similar fashion to Moses' delegation of his authority.

Exodus 18:21 Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens:

Proverbs 29:2 When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice but when the wicked rule, the people groan.

The Church's Withdrawal From The Public Sector Is A Sin Of Omission That Exposes All Of Society To Harmful Consequences. (Proverbs 29:2, Hosea 8:3-4, Deut. 28:20)

The church's withdrawal necessarily means the absence of the most potent influence for society's good. In the realm of government, the sinfulness of man coupled with the deceptions of the evil one will inevitably lead to misplaced, expanded power. Unrestrained government is a monster that will devour freedom and destroy prosperity, impacting everyone.

Proverbs 29:2 When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.

Hosea 8:3-4 Israel hath cast off the thing that is good: the enemy shall pursue him. They have set up kings, but not by me: they have made princes, and I knew it not: of their silver and their gold have they made them idols, that they may be cut off.

Deuteronomy 28:20 The Lord shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou setteth thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou perish quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

The Founding Fathers believed that nations, like individuals, are accountable to God; individuals answer to Him in the future, nations in the present. George Mason, the Father of the Bill of Rights, put it this way: "As nations cannot be rewarded or punished in the next world, they must be in this. By an inevitable chain of causes and effects, Providence punishes national sins by national calamities."

As an example, our country has ignored God's principles of fiscal responsibility. Individually and as a nation, we are people in debt, driven by immediate gratification. The federal government's debt is now over \$37 trillion (up from \$19 trillion since original printing of this book in 2012), an unfathomable figure, and several states are on the edge of insolvency. Sound, biblical principles have not informed financial policies and as a result a national calamity may be inevitable.

The Church's Participation In The Public Sector Is A Significant Way To Love Others, As We Seek The Peace And Prosperity Of Our Cities and Work Toward A Society That Embraces Biblical Morality. (Jeremiah. 29:7, Deut. 28:10-11)

In contrast to the negative consequences referenced above, adherence to God's truth inevitably brings blessings, which have a corporate as well as an individual application. America has been the beneficiary of countless blessings because of the biblical truth upon which this nation was founded; we have experienced unprecedented freedom and prosperity. In turn, we have been able to bless others. We have sent more missionaries around the world than any other nation. We have sent more aid in times of crisis. We have welcomed into our own country the poor and oppressed from other nations and provided for their needs.

Jeremiah 29:7 Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you prosper.

Deuteronomy 28:10–11 Then all peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you. And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

Scripture Links Prayer For Those In Authority With Peaceful Lives That Are Conducive To The Spread Of The Gospel.

(1 Tim. 2:1-4)

Underscoring the importance of prayer, Christian teacher and writer Ole Hallesby noted, "In prayer the Church has received power to rule the world... if it would stay together on its knees, it would dominate world politics—from the prayer room."

1 Tim. 2:1-4 I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. This... pleases God our Savior, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

We Are Called To Stand Up For His Truth, Whenever And Wherever It Is Challenged.

(Acts 5:29, Deut. 6:6-8)

Indeed, the public arena is precisely where God's truth will be challenged the most. Ephesians 6:13-18 tells us to "put on the full armor of God" so that we will be able to stand firm against Satan's schemes. Notably, the word of God (the sword) is the only offensive weapon mentioned. The Church must boldly use the sword, proclaiming the whole gospel, or others will be deprived of its power to transform lives.

In the public school's impressionable youth are rewarded (by the grading system, peer pressure, school policies, etc.) for embracing politically correct—but biblically hostile—concepts. Education is being replaced with agenda-driven indoctrination. This situation must be changed! As Herbert Hoover observed, "Children are our most valuable resource."

Acts 5:29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men."

Deuteronomy 6:6–8 And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.

How Do Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries Carry Out This Biblical Mandate?

A simple way to remember the primary means to accomplish our purposes is through the acronym PETER.

PRAYER: We are a prayer ministry first for our governmental officials. We pray for spiritual revival; we pray for our country and those in authority.

EDUICATION: We educate our members, enabling them to apply a biblical worldview to all areas of life, with emphasis on the proper roles of citizens, government and our constitution.

TAKE ACTION: We take action on topical issues and proposed legislation that has the most potential to influence our society for either good or evil.

ELECTIONS: We distribute non-partisan election information and voter guides so that our members will be equipped to vote in accordance with their biblical values; we register new voters.

RESTORATION: We repent and call upon God to bring healing and restoration to our nation, in accordance with 2 Chronicles 7:14.

Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministries are designed to be led by church volunteers, with minimal pastoral oversight. Volunteer leaders who are well grounded in a biblical worldview should be selected. The Salt and Light Council provides the framework and resources, while giving each church the opportunity to utilize, personalize and adapt these resources for their needs.

**Are There Lessons From History To Indicate That Christians Who Boldly Engage The Culture Can Have A Positive Impact?
YES!**

The abolition of slavery and the civil rights movement of the 1960's were largely the result of Christians engaging the culture. Indeed, our own American Revolution was strongly influenced by the preceding Great Awakening. The colonists were ready to stand up against the tyranny of the British crown because they knew the biblical basis for their fight. The history of the world has been dramatically shaped for good by the colonists' bold stand.

Our nation's history is a strong testimony to the corporate blessings that result when a nation is dedicated to biblical principles. The vast majority of our Founding Fathers were strong Christians who took their civic duties seriously. Their efforts laid the foundation for the most free and prosperous nation ever. We have the longest-running constitutional republic ever. We have never fought a foreign war on our soil. Immigrants from all over the world want to come here, the land of liberty and opportunity. These blessings have come as a consequence of the biblical basis of our government (and God has dealt mercifully with us despite many shortcomings.) The engraving on the Liberty Bell is from Leviticus 25:10 Proclaim liberty throughout the land unto all the inhabitants thereof. Liberty came first from God. Our Constitution enshrines that truth and provides for its practical application—the first such application in the world.

What About The Separation Of Church and State?

The original intention of our Founding Fathers was that there would be no approval by the government of a particular denomination of Christianity. But they clearly expected that Christianity would prevail. John Jay, our nation's first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and a prominent framer of the Constitution, stated, "Providence has given to our people the choice of their rulers, and it is the duty—as well as the privilege and interest—of our Christian nation to select and prefer Christians for their rulers." John Quincy Adams declared that the Declaration of Independence "laid the cornerstone of human government upon the first precepts of Christianity."

Thomas Jefferson, (whose use of the term "separation of church and state" has been mistakenly lifted out of its original context,) attended Sunday church services in the House of Representatives. Indeed, Christian services in the Capitol building continued until after the Civil War. The gospel was also preached in the Supreme Court chambers.

In short, the notion that the public sector should be scrubbed free of its Christian roots is tragically misguided, separating us from the very source of our corporate blessings.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge.

The material above has given you the biblical and practical basis for having a Salt & Light Biblical Citizenship Ministry at your church. The next Great Awakening begins with believers. Revival begins with you and me!
